

Wylie Independent School District desires to promote positive school spirit and a safe atmosphere at Wylie High School home football games. You can help us accomplish this by carefully reading and following the guidelines listed below. Please discuss these with your son or daughter. If you have questions or concerns, please contact me at your convenience.

- ◆ The general admission seating for High School students is in the far east side of the home stands(nearest to the field house) and **general admission seating for Junior High School students is in the far west side of the home stands(nearest to the scoreboard).**
- ◆ **Students may not loiter or block the main walkway at the bottom of the stands, or the concession/restroom area underneath the bleachers.** In addition, students/children may not stand at the fence or in the handicap seating area.
- ◆ **Students need to refrain from entering and leaving the seating area multiple times throughout the game and also refrain from moving from seat to seat in the bleachers during the game.**
- ◆ No balls, footballs, or game objects will be brought into the stadium by students or fans.
- ◆ No students may be on the track or on the sidelines unless they are part of the activities and have an appropriate field pass. (UIL regulation)
- ◆ All students and fans from Wylie must remain on the home side at all times. (UIL regulation)
- ◆ Wylie police officers and school personnel will be on duty at each home game to offer assistance and provide a safe atmosphere for all students and fans.

Please help us promote positive school spirit in the following manner:

- Support all players, coaches, and officials in a positive manner
- Participate in the cheers with the cheerleaders
- Support the band, flag corps and drill team during half-time performances.
