



## 2009 Wylie ISD Prekindergarten (PK) Thursday, April 16th, 2009

4:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m.

Location: Your child's elementary campus

The Wylie Independent School district offers a half-day Prekindergarten program for students who are four years old, on or before Sept. 1, 2009.

### Bring your child to Pre-K registration.

#### Documents required to Register:

- *Birth Certificate*
- *Immunization Record*
- *Social Security card for child*
- *Proof of Residency (Recent utility bill—water, gas, electric—with name and address, Lease Agreement, Builder's Contract with completion date)*
- *Driver's License of Parent or legal guardian enrolling student or valid picture ID*

### PREKINDERGARTEN ELIGIBILITY

The child must be four-years old on or before September 1, 2009 AND meet at least one of the following criteria.

- One or both parents were injured or killed while serving on active duty of the US Armed Forces.
- One or both parents are currently active military
- Child is homeless, as defined by federal law
- Child is educationally disadvantaged based on income will qualify for the free/reduced lunch program. (Applications will be accepted starting July 1, 2009 at Support Center-Food Service. If you have questions please call Tina Slocum at 972-429-2333.)
- English is not primary language for the student; based on assessment results.
- Child has ever been in the conservatorship (foster care) of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following an adversary Hearing

***Please note: If the child qualifies for Prekindergarten—Tibbals and Whitt do not have a PK program; Tibbals Elementary PK students will go to Smith Elementary and Whitt Elementary PK students will go to Cox Elementary. .***

### TRANSPORTATION:

Prekindergarten students are not eligible for transportation; unless enrolled in Head Start Program.

### SCHOOL HOURS:

7:30 a.m.—10:30 a.m. (Morning Session)

11:45 a.m.—2:45 p.m. (Afternoon Session)

Head Start—7:30 a.m.—2:30 p.m.

**Head Start is located at Smith Elementary** and is a full-day program. Students must also qualify under federal guidelines for this program.

### You MUST report to your home campus before completing an application for Head Start.

- Eligibility: A child is educationally disadvantaged based on income will qualify for the free/reduced lunch program.

### 4 YEAR OLDS—PREKINDERGARTEN

5 doses of DTP/DTaP/DT with 5<sup>th</sup> dose on/after 4th birthday OR 4 doses if the 4th dose is on/after the 4th birthday

4 doses of Polio with 4<sup>th</sup> dose on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday OR 3 doses if 3<sup>rd</sup> dose is on/after 4th birthday

2 doses of MMR with first dose on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

\*HIB 1 dose of HIB on/after 15 months OR 3 doses

\*PCV-7/Prevnar 1 dose of -PCV on/or after 24 months of age OR 4 doses with one given after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday OR 2 doses if given between 12 -24 months of age

3 doses of Hepatitis B

2 dose of varicella on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (if the child has NOT had chickenpox)

2 doses of Hepatitis A 1<sup>st</sup> dose on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

\*HIB and PCV7 not routinely recommended to children > 5 years of age
