BIRTHDAYS



Math (complete 1 section each night)


Any notes that have been sent home should also be shared with a parent or guardian.

Homework should be done neatly and to the best of your child's ability.


CLASSROOM RULES




- 1. Listen when others are talking.

Student will earn numerical/letter grades. The following is a breakdown of how grades are calculated.



B = 80-89



We have 1 big field trip planned for this school year! More details will come home closer to the date of the trip.


