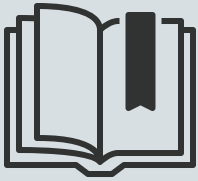


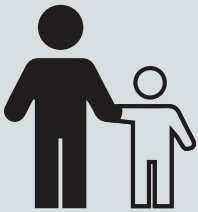


Wylie ISD Student Wellness & Reproductive Health



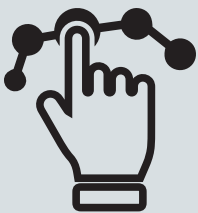
TEKS-Based:

The Student Wellness and Reproductive Health Unit is based on the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills for Health in grades 6, 7, and 9. The unit is taught during science class.
