

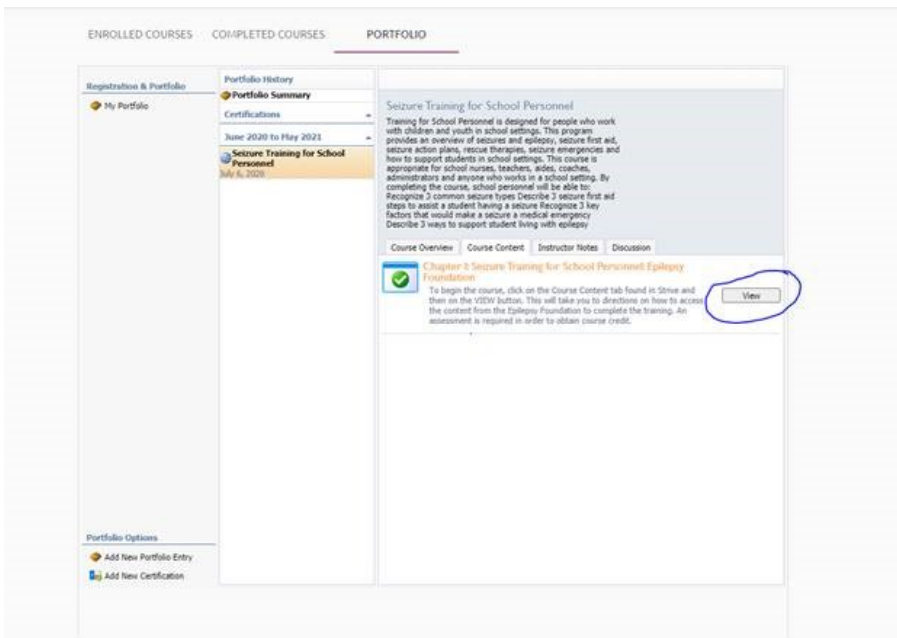
Enrolling in and Uploading your seizure certificate

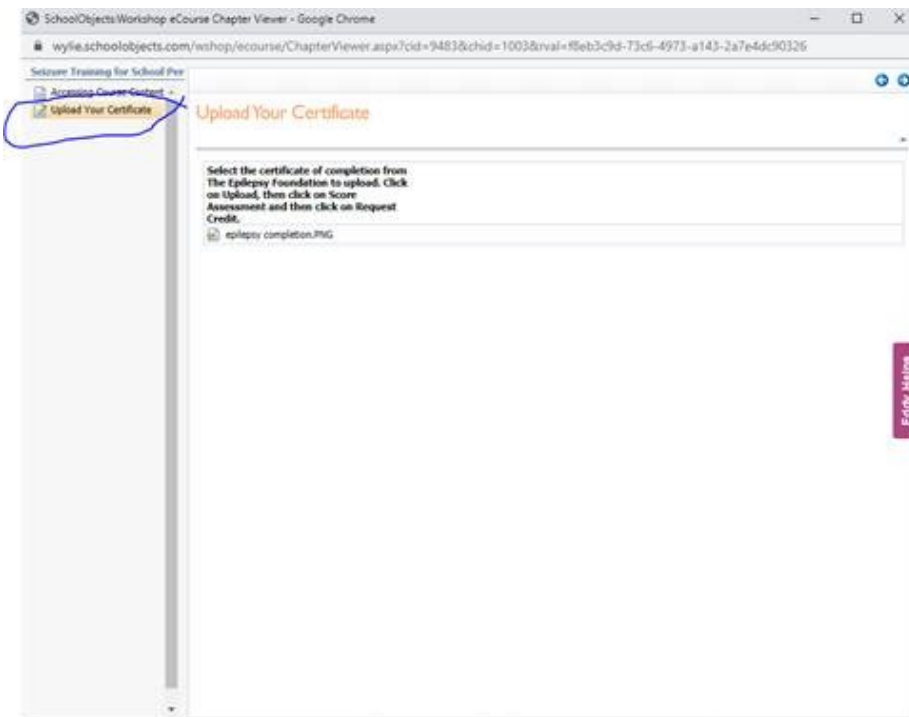
1. Click "Enroll" in the top left corner
2. Click on "My professional Learning > "Enrolled Courses" > "Seizure Training for School Personnel"
5. A new screen will pop up. Click course content
6. Under course content click "view"
7. This will open a new window which will give you a link to begin the course
