Bush Elementary will:

- 1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards as follows:**
 - Follow district curriculum in all subjects
 - Provide differentiated instruction based on student needs
 - Provide small group tutoring before, during, and after school
 - Provide adult mentors for at-risk students
 - Monitor student achievement through formative and summative assessments
- 2. Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least twice annually in elementary schools) during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.** Specifically, those conferences will be held:
 - October 2016
 - March 2017
- 3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.** Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:
 - Report cards will be sent home the Thursday following the end of each nine weeks grading period.
 - Progress reports will be sent home each Thursday following the 3rd week of the nine weeks grading period.
- 4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff.**
 - Staff members are available after school and during their planning period each school day.
- 5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities,** as follows:

*Parents may volunteer through the parent volunteer program with PTA after attending the parent volunteer training and a criminal background screening. Parents may volunteer during the school day, after school, or on weekends.
Parents may observe 1 hour each semester in their child's classroom after requesting and receiving permission from the school principal.*
